How to access Online Course Link (keycode)

Heartcode BLS/ Heartcode ACLS/ Heartcode PALS

A “Course Link” [example highlighted above] will be found in your confirmation email.

You can either click on the link directly or copy & paste your link into your browser.

We do not recommend that you type in the link manually.
